Medina, OH. March 10, 2017 – The Medina County Economic Development Corporation (MCEDC) has organized an Employer Resources Expo on April 4, 2017 at Weymouth Country Club from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM.

According to Bethany Dentler, Executive Director of MCEDC, the expo was put together after meeting with hundreds of companies who said that finding workers was the number one challenge facing companies in all sectors. “It became clear that we needed to help companies find solutions to workforce issues, and we knew there are great organizations in our region that could help. We hope that by bringing everyone together in one space, we can match up resource providers with growing businesses,” said Dentler.

“With an unemployment rate of 4.3%, Medina County businesses can’t count on people to be available like they used to be. Today, they have to keep the employees they have and find populations of workers they are not currently targeting,” added Kathy Breitenbucher, Business Development Manager.

Booths at the event will feature organizations who work with populations of people ready to go to work, provide training resources, and offer retention strategies and advice on workforce issues.

The expo will be open to visitors all day, and will also feature breakout sessions in the morning and afternoon to focus on specific topics such as employee engagement, benefits and pre-employment testing.
